

**The group will leave on the LSBC Bus on Thursday, June 23, and arrive on Saturday, June 25, spending two nights en route. The group will leave on Saturday, July 2, arriving home on Sunday, July 3, spending one night en route.** For those who cannot ride the bus due to time off from work considerations, I will assist you in making airline reservations on your own.

**The cost for the trip is as follows:**

**PITTSBURGH PORTION—required of ALL participants**

**Trip items and services listed below (less room) - \$125.00**

**Hotel room - \$1,075.00 (less trip donations, divided by number of occupants or families)**

**The following items and services are included in the package:**

- Lodging for 7 nights in Pittsburgh, June 25-July 1
- Continental breakfast for 7 days
- Lunches each day at Music Camp
- Ticket to Pittsburgh Pirate Game
- Admission to historic Kennywood Amusement Park (one of the nation's oldest)
- Sightseeing in downtown Pittsburgh and SW Pennsylvania mountains, including pre-revolutionary war historic sights and Frank Lloyd Wright's *Falling Water* home.

**Not Included:**

- Meals not specified
- Items of a personal nature
- Metro to downtown Pittsburgh and Pirate game

**BUS TRAVEL PORTION—based on three nights of lodging**

**Trip items and services listed below (less room) - \$25.00**

**Hotel room - \$425.00 (divided by number of occupants or families)**

**The following are included in these amounts:**

- Two nights lodging on the way to Pittsburgh and One night lodging on the way home
- Continental breakfast for 3 days
- 4 Lunches at picnic/rest areas en route
- Bus fuel (this is provided as a budgeted item)

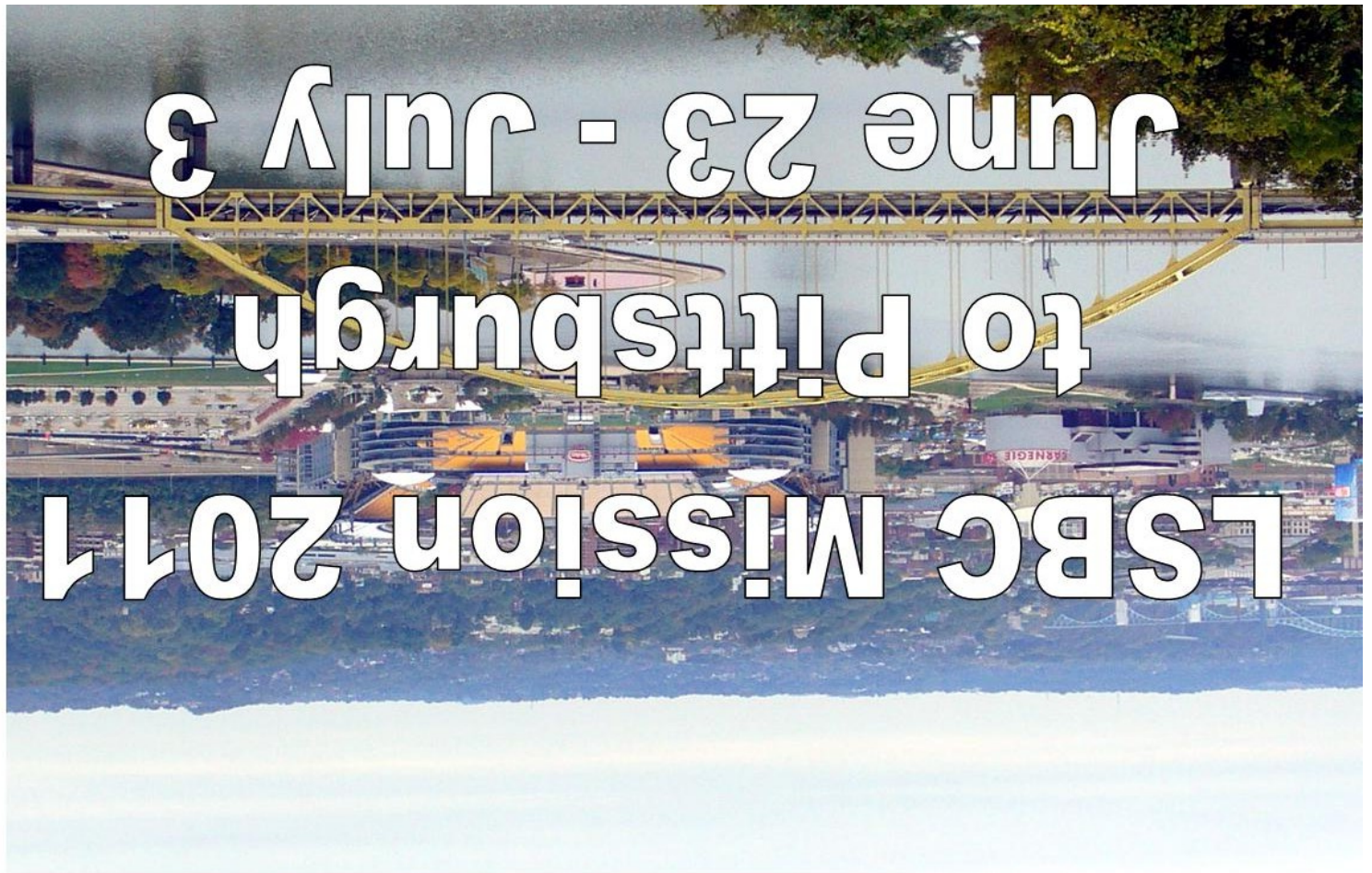
**Not Included:**

**A \$100 non-refundable deposit will be required at registration,** which will be applied to each individual's trip. The remaining balance will be due in installments **on April 24 and May 15. The final date for cancellation with a refund will be May 24.**

**All donations to the trip will be applied to the total hotel cost of the group,** since donations are not tax-deductible when specified to individuals as scholarships. Designated donations to a specific person will NOT be accepted through the church office, and therefore, should be made directly to that person.

While the focus of this trip is its primary mission, there will also be time for participants to enjoy the sights of this beautiful country, including the French and Indian War historic sites, Frank Lloyd Wright homes, and the beautiful scenery of the Allegheny Mountains and downtown Pittsburgh.

**WHAT IF I'M NOT MUSICAL?** There will be plenty for everyone to do. Only a few of the workers needed for Music/Sports Camp must be musical. We need small group helpers, kitchen help, community surveyors, bus workers, and volunteers to hand out concert flyers, just to name a few.

**HOW ARE WE GETTING THERE?** Most of the group will be riding our church bus. Those who cannot be away from work responsibilities for more than one week are welcome to make their own air arrangements (frequent flyer miles, etc.) or I will assist in the process. The only requirement for this group is that you arrive in Pittsburgh by 2 p. m. on June 25.

**WHERE ARE WE STAYING?** We will be staying in a local motel for seven nights.

**WHAT ABOUT FUND RAISING?** We will make every effort to raise funds to cover as much of the trip as possible. These will include the Spring Dinner Theater. We will also have individuals who would like to help fund the trip. A change for this trip is that all donations will be applied to the hotel cost and reduce the cost of the trip for ALL participants.

**WHAT ABOUT SCHOLARSHIPS?** There may be those who need financial assistance and donors willing to provide it. If you need such assistance, you must make this known to Ed in writing to be matched to a donor, but there is no guarantee of assistance. No one will be allowed to register without the accompanying \$100 deposit.
